

Schedule of gas standard variable rates for non-domestic customers

These charges have been set out by British Gas Trading Limited. If your terms and conditions are for small businesses, our standard variable rates apply only in exceptional circumstances. If you choose not to agree a new energy plan with us when your current plan ends, you'll automatically move to our variable price plan instead of our standard variable rates.

If your terms and conditions are for large and corporate businesses, the standard variable rates published in this document will apply where a fixed-term contract has ended but you have not left our supply and have not agreed a new contract with us.

From 1st April 2024, all gas supplies that this schedule applies to will be charged in accordance with the rates set out below. Our standard variable rate may be higher than our contract prices, so please contact us to see if we can offer you a better price. These charges will also apply to non-domestic customers using piped propane supplied under arrangements in Llanfyllin, Llanwrtyd Wells, Colden and Stornoway.

These charges are subject to withdrawal and can be changed with 30 days' written notice.

Standard variable rates

The charges in the table below set out our standard variable rates. These rates apply in the circumstances described above in all areas supplied by us and comprise a standing charge and a unit rate for all gas supplied for non-domestic purposes. All prices are excluding VAT, which will be charged at the prevailing rate applicable to your business and Climate Change Levy (CCL).

Small non-daily meter

Means a single non-domestic site where the annual quantity held with the Transporter is less than 732,000 kWh per year (approximately 25,000 therms) and is part of a British Gas gas supply contract.

Large non-daily meter

Means either a single non-domestic site that is part of a British Gas gas supply contract where the annual quantity held with the Transporter is equal to or greater than 732,000 kWh per year (approximately 25,000 therms).

Daily meter

Means a site that is part of a British Gas gas supply contract and has an associated 'daily read equipment'. A site with any annual quantity can be registered as a daily metered site; however, it is mandatory where the annual quantity held with the Transporter is greater than 58,600,000 kWh per year (approximately 2,000,000 therms).
